Since joining the Bangladesh Foreign Service in 1991, Mr. Khundoker served in the Ministry in various capacities including Deputy Chief of Protocol, Director in the Foreign Secretary's Office, Director General (External Publicity) and Director General for SAARC and BIMSTEC. He also served in different capacities in Bangladesh Missions in Manila, London and Ottawa. He also headed Bangladesh Deputy High Commission in Kolkata, India from 2008-2010.
